The Canada Pipeline Project Work report highlights various Canadian pipeline construction projects, recently completed, under construction, and future projects announced by pipeline transmission companies operating in Canada.

Mainline Pipeline Construction refers to projects with pipelines up to 48 inches in diameter. They transport high pressure natural gas and petroleum products to and from processing facilities, wellheads, refineries and storage facilities to downstream customers across the country.

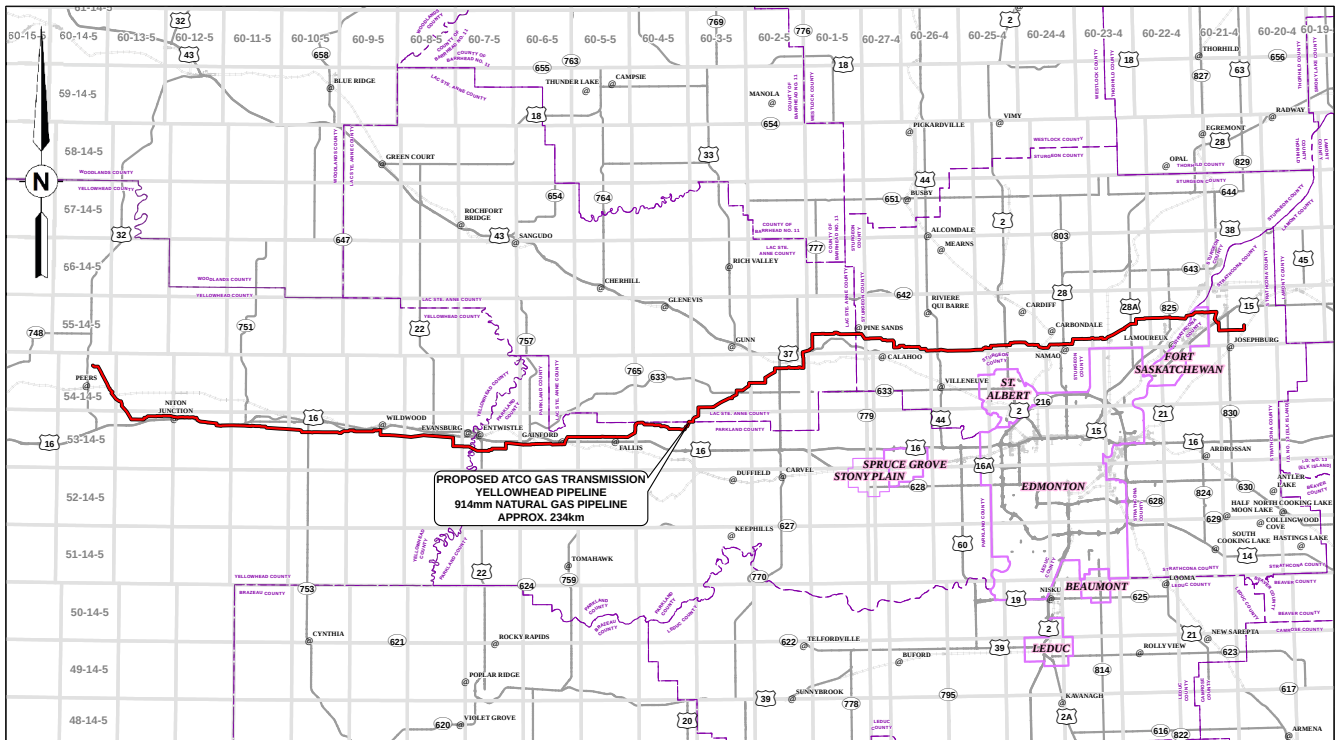
Mid-Inch Pipeline Construction refers to pipelines predominately operating within the midstream pipeline sector. These pipelines generally operate at both high and low pressures. They are generally 24 inches in diameter or less.

Distribution Pipeline Construction refers to pipelines that are typically 6 inches or less in diameter. They operate at lower pressures than mainline pipelines and they are utilized in the distribution of gas, oil and other products downstream from metering stations to stations or meters within the industrial, commercial and residential markets.

Pipeline Maintenance and Service refers to the work done to maintain the integrity of various pipelines through various techniques such as repair, re-coating, non-destructive testing and removal.

The ATCO Yellowhead Mainline involves building approximately 235 kilometers (KM) of 36-Inch diameter natural gas pipeline

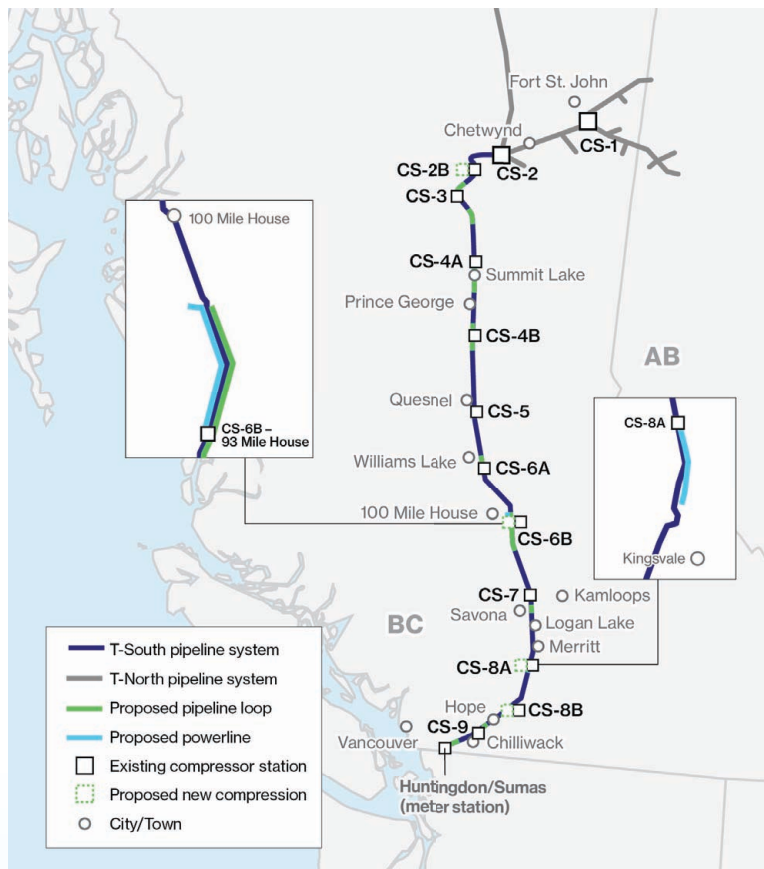


The ATCO Yellowhead Mainline Project approximate start date is the 3rd Quarter 2026

Prince Rupert Gas Transmission involves building approximately 702 kilometers (KM) of 48 – Inch diameter natural gas pipeline

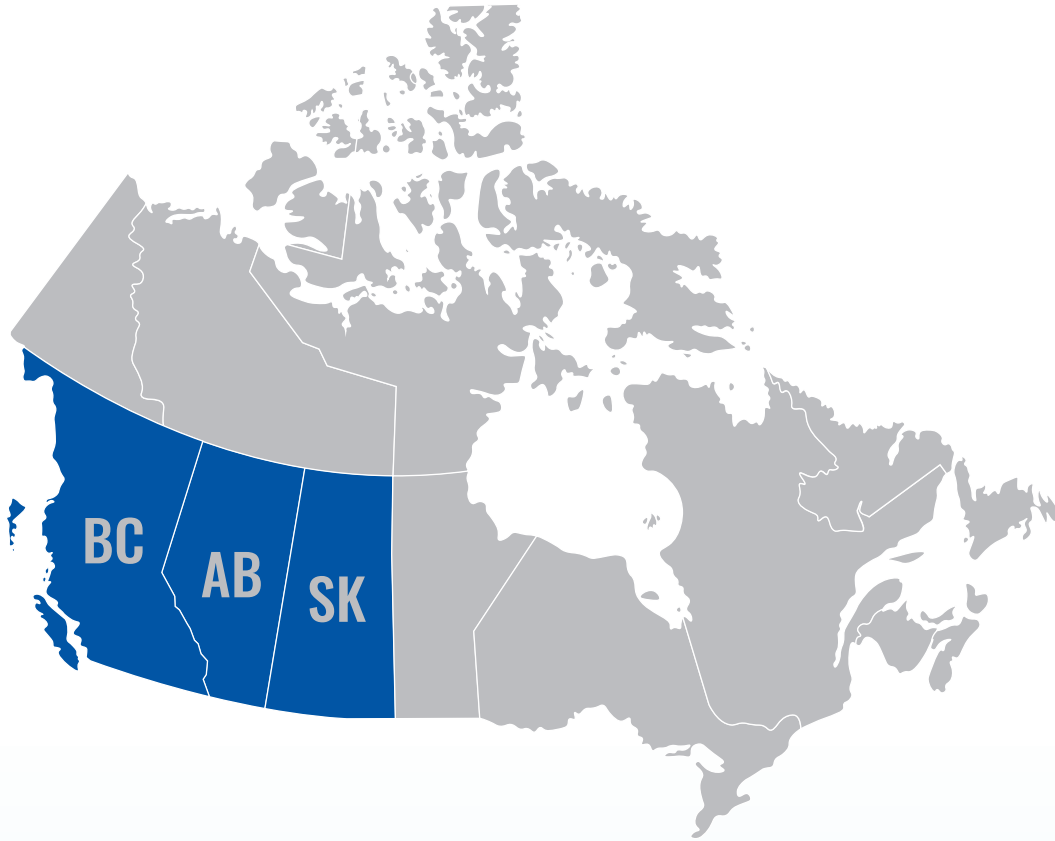


The Prince Rupert Gas Transmission project approximate start date is the 2nd Quarter of 2027



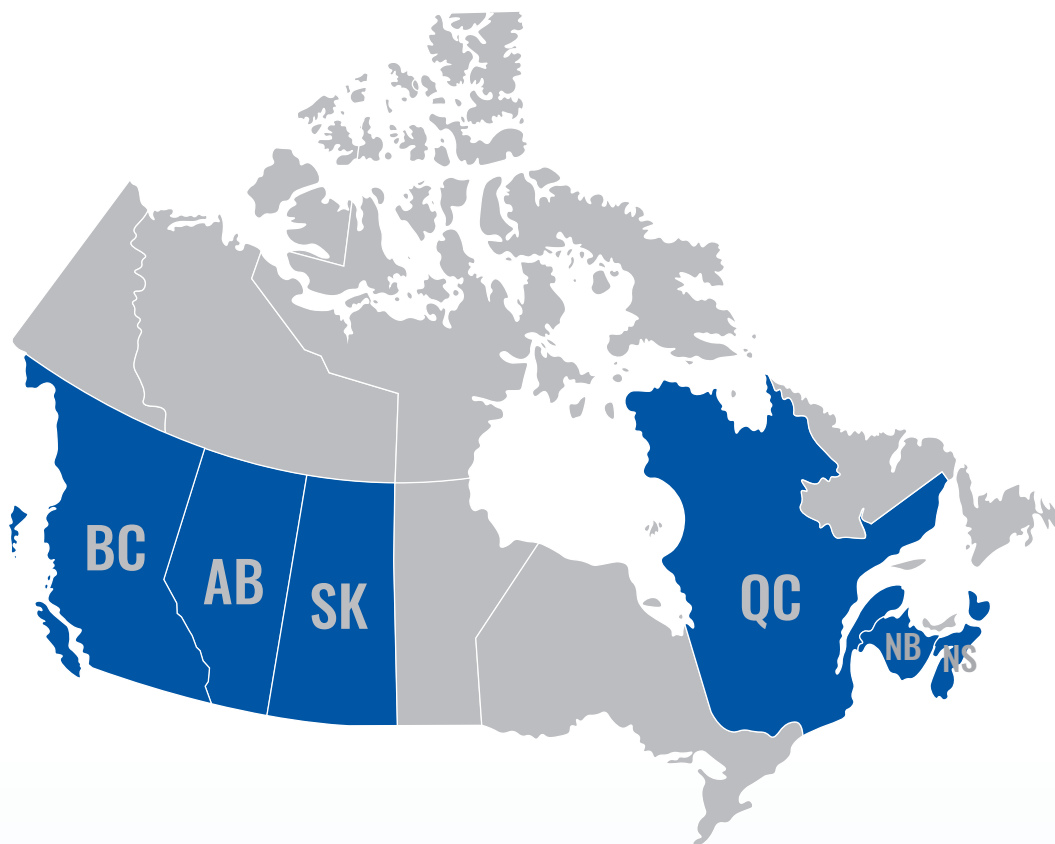

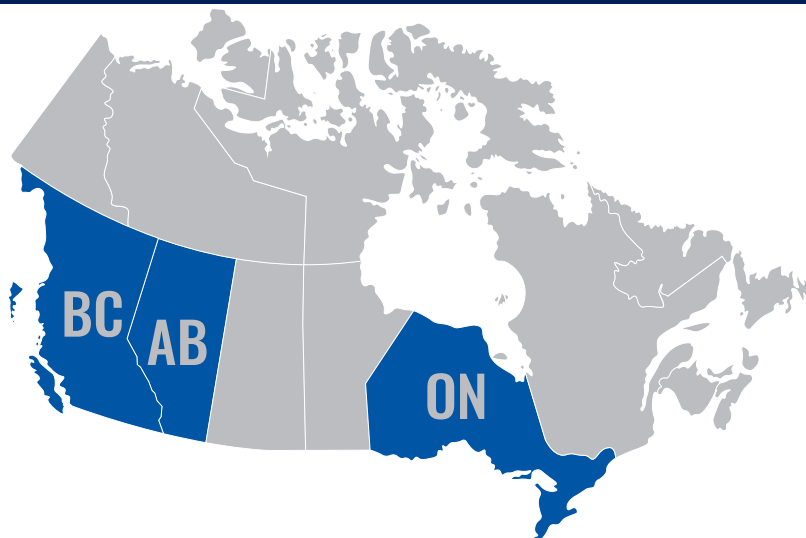
